Cacao beans	Cacao trees sprout pods directly from						
	their trunks. When they are ripe, the						
	pods can be broken open to reveal						
	the beans, which can then be dried,						
	roasted and ground.

#### Key Events

In 300BC, El Mirador became large and powerful but by AD 900 cities in the rainforest were abandoned due to extensive drought. This caused people to move north to the highlands of Guatemala and the Yucatan.
