Key Vocabulary—to use

E-book A book that can be read on the computer or on a tablet.

Text Words, letters, numbers or symbols entered into a computer, such as writing text in 2Create a Story.

Email Messages distributed by electronic means from one computer user to one or more people.

Internet A way to send information from one computer to another anywhere in the world using technology such as phones, satellites and radio links.

Key Vocabulary—to hear

Personal information This is information that is personal to someone. For example, their favourite food, their name and age.

Connection Represent a relationship or link between two nodes or ideas.

Key Questions

- What is an email? An email is a way of sending messages electronically from one device to another. An email can have items such as pictures and videos attached to it.
- What is 2Create a Story? With 2Create a Story, you can create e-books including animated pages, sounds, narration and music.
- How does a concept map help share ideas? A concept map in 2Connect allows many users to contribute to the map which means that ideas or concepts can be quickly amended or additional information provided
