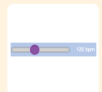

## How can I make my own soundtrack?

- To upload a sound from a bank of sounds into the Sounds section. To record your own sound and upload it into the Sounds section. To create your own tune using the sounds which they have added to the Sounds section



Changes the beats per minute in the music



Increase or decrease the volume of an instrument



Choose the digital instrument to use



Delete the music



Open, save and share a piece of your music



Change the number of quavers in the music



Loop or unloop the piece of music



Play the composed tune

## Key Vocabulary

**Beat** A rhythmic unit in music.

**Sound Effect** A sound other than speech or music.

**Soundtrack** A recording of the musical accompaniment of a film or tv programme. **Speed** The number of beats per minute (bpm) played in the music.

**Tempo** The speed at which the music plays.

**Volume** How loud or quiet the music is.

**Compose** To create a piece of music.

**Note** A single tone in music.

**Tune** Musical notes joined together to make a melody.

## Key Questions

- What is meant by digital music?

Digital music is made using a computer or other device. Digital music allows the computer to copy the sound made by instruments and combine them together to make a piece of music.

- How can I change how my music sounds?

You can change how your digital music sounds in many ways. One way is to increase the tempo of the music or vary the volume of each instrument in the piece.

- What is it meant by the tempo of the music?

Tempo is measured in BPM, or beats per minute. One beat every second is 60 BPM.
